

KEY FEATURES THAT MATTER MOST TO BUSINESS: PRODUCTIVITY

BlackBerry Flow

With BlackBerry Flow, the barriers that exist between applications are eliminated, so apps work together and share information with each other, creating an intuitive, flexible interface that boosts productivity and efficiency. Flow gives users greater control over their experience, through gestures and interactions that reflect how they interact with objects in the real world.

At a business conference, you're exchanging a number of emails with colleagues who are also attending. You need to regroup for a lunch meeting before the next session starts. Launching the BlackBerry Calendar, you start to fill in the meeting details with a few quick taps on the keyboard. After typing the subject "Lunch Meeting," you begin to add colleagues—and the names of other colleagues you've been speaking with about the meeting are automatically suggested. You simply tap on the suggested names to add them to the invite, hit **Send** and you're done. As you head to your hotel room for a conference call with colleagues back in the office, you pull up the calendar and use People View to quickly scan the attendees. Tapping on a colleague's name brings up their related communications, and you see a social update that they just returned from a Napa vacation. Settling into the meeting, you snap back to the calendar, which has the email with the presentation you need and quickly open it up; off you go while the person on the other line is still fumbling through their in-box. As your colleague calls in and the presentation is about to get started, you greet her by saying, "Hi, Alex! How was Napa?"

Hub

BlackBerry Hub is designed to help users stay responsive and in control. It's a unified in-box for email, BlackBerry Messenger (BBM), social feeds and more, speeding up response time by allowing users to respond directly from BlackBerry Hub without signing into specific apps. BlackBerry Hub empowers users to:

- + Seize opportunities.
- + Better manage conversations as they unfold in real time, with tools to help sort, prioritize and action all conversations, from emails to social networks.
- + Stay on top of conversations with the "Peek" gesture, which lets users look in at conversations while on the go, from any app.

You're on a video conference when your notification LED flashes to let you know you've got a message. Rather than interrupt the conference to check, you **Peek** back to your in-box. You can see what type of message it is, who it's from and the start of the subject line. All the while, the video conference carries on in the background uninterrupted. The message isn't that important, so you just let the in-box snap back into place. When a name you don't immediately recognize comes up on the call, you move into the **Hub** to search and pull up their contact card, social network updates and emails. When the LED flashes again, you **Peek** in and see you need to answer it immediately. So you go straight into your in-box to reply. Once you're done, you return to your conference with just a swipe.

Peek

The Peek gesture allows users to peek into the message center from any application at any time, to see new messages. A simple gesture brings the in-box in from the left to display the latest messages. Move it all the way across to go to the in-box, or let it snap back if messages can wait.



Stay close to what's important—keep everything that matters in one place. Simply peek into the BlackBerry Hub from any app with just a swipe, and flow effortlessly in and out of messages and conversations.

Calendar

The calendar has been designed to make meeting scheduling a breeze. It remembers the participants of previous meetings, subject lines and email addressees, so that when a new meeting is created, it suggests attendees based on those previous meetings. Relevant documents are easy to find from a tab in the event listing. Touching on a meeting participant accesses their latest social updates, company information and more. And when it's time for the meeting, join the conference call with a single click, with simplified conference call setup integrated into calendar appointments—so there's no more memorizing conference codes.



CALENDAR IN ACTION

You're setting up an earnings conference call in the BlackBerry Calendar. After typing the subject and adding the first attendee, the names of the other people you may need are automatically suggested from emails you've already exchanged on the subject, ensuring vital personnel will be included. In a few taps, all your essential attendees have received an invite. Tapping on your next scheduled meeting that day lets you ensure that attendees for that meeting have received the PowerPoint* document you've sent. And tapping on meeting attendees' names lets you check out everyone's latest social network updates and messages so you can skip the small talk and get right down to business.

BlackBerry Remember

BlackBerry Remember is the project app users need to stay organized and on top of their resources. With a tap, users can compile project photos, Web pages, emails and Web sites into workbooks for easy access. BlackBerry Remember for a particular interest or project lets users gather messages, images or lists in one place and tag them, to make finding important information fast. Plus, all tasks and actions can be synced with Evernote and Outlook® to-do lists.



BLACKBERRY REMEMBER IN ACTION

You're redesigning your store's merchandise display, using BlackBerry Remember to help you organize and manage all of the details, information and ideas you have. You receive quotes on the new shelving via email, which you add to a new Remember folder titled Shelving, then create a task to remind you to review them and decide on Monday. Later, while you're out, a display in another store catches your eye—so you snap a photo and add it to the Remember folder called Display Ideas. Tagging this new photo with the keywords "display," "merchandise" and "ideas" means it'll be easy to find with Universal Search when you meet with your contractor and store executives tomorrow. With the help of Remember, you can be confident your redesign and relaunch will come in on time and on budget.

BlackBerry Messenger

The BlackBerry Messenger customers know and love is now enhanced with new ways to share experiences as they happen. The new Screen Share feature on BBM enhances the sharing experience with the added ability to share photos, videos, the view from the camera, a browser page or a business document with a BBM contact. And the new BBM Groups allows group sharing of photos; the creation of group lists and group calendars; and live group chats. It's a new BBM experience for a new generation of BlackBerry smartphones.

BBM Video

With just a tap, switch your BBM chat to a BBM Video conversation and meet face-to-face. Video conversations offer the same real-time sharing features as chat does, so you can share photos, browser pages, documents and more as you continue to chat. It's a new BBM experience for a new generation of BlackBerry smartphones.





BBM IN ACTION

In a hotel room just an hour away from a sales meeting, you need to quickly review the presentation with a colleague back at the office. You check to make sure they're available with BBM chat, and then with a push of the button, share the screen with the PowerPoint presentation. Together, you review it slide by slide to ensure that all bases are covered and updates are made, all in real time.

BBM VIDEO IN ACTION

You and a colleague need to discuss a complex model you designed for a client, so you need the ability to meet face to face. By simply tapping the **Video Chat** button in BBM, you instantly turn your BBM chat into a live video chat. So that you can both review the vital information you need to make decisions, you tap the **Camera Share** button and your colleague now sees the view from your camera. While you continue to chat, you direct your camera at the items your teammate needs to see. This real-time collaboration allows you and your colleague to ensure things get done right the first time.

Typing Experience

BlackBerry 10 offers an intuitive, fluid typing experience that speeds up communication and increases accuracy. It learns from past messages to understand how a user writes, and then accurately tailors next-word predictions. The keyboard will even suggest the next word before the another letter is typed—and then that word can be simply flicked onto the message. When a user adds multilanguage predictive text, they receive suggested words in the languages they've selected.

TYPING IN ACTION

As you tap the **H** key with your thumb, the word "**hey**" appears over the letter **E**, where your thumb and your eyes are already headed. Flick that word up onto the page, and the keyboard has already guessed your next word: "**how**" is now hovering above the **H**. With a series of subsequent flicks, you complete your sentence: "**was**" "**your**" "**day**" "?". BlackBerry 10 knows you type differently in emails and BlackBerry Messenger—so it knows what words to suggest when you're messaging. All that's left for you to do is send.



Contacts

Users can remember prior interactions and be better prepared for the next meeting with the BlackBerry 10 contacts experience. It aggregates information from social-media Web sites, prior and upcoming meetings and phone calls for each contact in the phonebook. And it pulls company information into the contact record based on the corporation those contacts are affiliated with, providing the in-depth information workers need to stay on top of business interactions.

Updated Browser UI

The updated BlackBerry 10 browser interface lets users quickly access and share the best of the Web—safely and securely, with built-in personal information protection. Web pages load quickly, with all advanced elements supported. A press of the Share button enables sharing with any service—and BlackBerry 10 remembers preferred sharing methods.

ROWSER IN ACTION

You're reading an article on a Web page that you want to share. When you hit the **Share** button, you see a short menu of sharing options—and **Send as Email** is already highlighted because BlackBerry 10 knows that you usually share Web pages via email. With the link in the body of the email, you type in the name of the group you want to share to and quickly add a few comments. Once you send, you're returned back to the Web page. As you continue reading, you see a quote that you want to add to something you're working on, so you highlight the text and hit **Share** again, bringing up the menu. This time, you select **Send to BlackBerry Remember**, select your project and save. And then you're sent back to the Web page where you started—all without losing your place.

BlackBerry World

The new BlackBerry World™ lets users share and discover a world of music, movies, TV shows and more with the people they know and trust. They can share apps in person by tapping devices together (Near Field Communication, or NFC), and see which apps others are downloading.

Built-in Business Applications

Documents to Go

Documents to Go is Microsoft Office-compatible and comes standard, letting users work on documents anywhere. Users can create, view, edit and present Word, Excel® and PowerPoint documents, and view and annotate Adobe® PDFs.

Print to Go

Print to Go lets users easily transfer documents from the office to the smartphone. Files are converted, encrypted and wirelessly pushed to the smartphone over Wi-Fi.

BlackBerry and NFC Tags

Users can share content and information through BlackBerry Tag. It enables the BlackBerry smartphone to act like a contactless card, and facilitates the replacement of plastic cards for payment, ticketing, access control and loyalty. Plus, with NFC tags, users can invite a contact to BBM, exchange information and share files, videos, pictures and music.

BlackBerry File Manager

Users have their office in the palms of their hands with BlackBerry File Manager, the app that lets them work with files and folders the way they're used to. Zip, unzip, copy, paste, move, rename, sort, search, share and manage files with ease.

Built-in Mapping and Navigation

What happens in Balance stays in Balance. BlackBerry Balance offers a seamless dual persona that provides a true separation of work and personal device use. It's like having two BlackBerry devices in one, keeping costs down for IT and ensuring that employees have the device they want to use. No client download is required and the user setup experience is easy; it's employee-owned device (EOD)-ready with built-in separation. Data is secured and protected at the platform and file level, making BlackBerry Balance an advanced perimeter technology.

The end-user experience is seamless and intuitive, designed with elegant flow and powerful control. With a simple tap and swipe, the user can select between the Personal and Work perimeter. Hybrid apps ensure the user

experience is made simple, while IT security and control are not compromised.

Balance Mode offers automatically enabled security features:

- + Separate work and personal email accounts
- + Creation of an encrypted Corporate File System (encrypted using 256-bit AES)
- + Creation of a Corporate Tab within the Navigator (for pushed corporate applications)
- + Creation of a Corporate Channel within BlackBerry World (for optional corporate applications)
- + Definition of a password (with password complexity) to gain access to the corporate file system, apps and data

BlackBerry World for Work*

Applications drive value, and BlackBerry World for Work provides a simple, manageable and scalable tool for secure deployment of enterprise apps. In addition to the vast range of off-the-shelf business, productivity and collaboration apps available in BlackBerry World, businesses can mobilize and deploy their own business apps directly and easily with the open development platform, tools and APIs. Because enterprise apps are only deployable within the work perimeter, BlackBerry Balance protects against any data leaks, or any malicious attempts to access enterprise data or connectivity associated with enterprise apps. And administrators can automatically deliver updates to keep apps secure and upgraded.

Authentication

BlackBerry Enterprise Service 10 gives administrators advanced and granular control over device authentication, with two options: passwords and certificates. Mandate a user password to access the Work perimeter, or require a password to gain access to the BlackBerry 10 device itself. Password policy can be enforced with rules like length, timeout before device lock, complexity and more, while all certificates are encrypted and protected within

the BlackBerry 10 KeyStore. And with the industry-standard Simple Certificate Enrollment Protocol (SCEP), BlackBerry 10 also makes it easy for an administrator to issue or renew certificates for authentication to corporate Wi-Fi, VPN, intranet and servers.

QNX MicroKernel

The BlackBerry 10 platform, a hardened version of QNX, offers a number of major security benefits. Vulnerabilities are avoided right out of the gate with the platform's limited code base. And because less code means a fixed amount of resources, security verification and testing is more thorough and robust. Overall, the platform is designed for resiliency, with processes carefully supervised, minimized and isolated outside the kernel—meaning the highest level of security is always efficiently maintained.

S/MIME Support

BlackBerry 10 offers the security of native, industrystandard, end-to-end encrypted and signed email. With the ease of seamless integration into the Unified Inbox, S/MIME support satisfies the security and productivity needs of both administrators and users.

EXCHANGE ACTIVESYNC

BlackBerry 10 and Exchange ActiveSync

BlackBerry 10 empowers users to get up and running right out of the box with Exchange ActiveSync. Full wireless email and PIM sync, with ActiveSync security, are immediately available, without the need for additional software, hardware or resources. With Internet access, the user can simply configure their account by adding the email address and password from their BlackBerry 10 device. This provides full email and PIM connectivity with Microsoft Exchange ActiveSync configuration, security and encryption.

Account Access

BlackBerry 10 devices come with full Exchange ActiveSync support. Users can instantly connect to onsite server systems or even those in the cloud simply and with minimum administration and cost. They just enter the appropriate user and server details in the setup menu to start receiving email and syncing calendar and contacts.





Profile Management

- + Android and iOS devices:
 - Profiles are pushed to the devices during initial activation or when applied to a user account or group.

 - Microsoft Exchange ActiveSync profiles can be created to automate Exchange ActiveSync registration on a user's device.
 - Compliance profiles help enforce corporate requirements for applications via a notification to users, through limitations on users' access to corporate resources and applications or by deleting data from the device.

BlackBerry Balance provides unrestricted personal use without impacting corporate security, and a seamless end-user experience for employee-owned devices. Balance is created automatically during initial activation with BlackBerry Enterprise Service 10 to establish a secure work perimeter for business data and applications.






